

Curriculum Feed Back Summary

Institution obtained feedback on the syllabus and its transactions at the institution from the following stakeholders: (a) Students; (b) Teachers; and (c) Employers. For students, an online survey was conducted using a well structured questionnaire. For this survey, 156 students were selected randomly from all the classes. From thirteen teachers, the feedback was obtained on a questionnaire. From the selected employers, the feedback was obtained through telephonic conversation. Due to COVID, employers at a wider scale could not be contacted; it is based on response of few employers. The summary of feedback is as follows:

Feedback from Students

- The Curriculum followed by our institution is useful for employment opportunities and is also relevant to real time situations.
- Depth of the course content is good and it is related to job oriented application.
- Overall Rating of current syllabus by the students is good.
- The students appreciated the revision of syllabus done in the recent past.
- Students suggested that various Add-on Courses should be introduced.
- Students feel the need of annual system in place of semester system.

Feedback from Teachers

- ICT infrastructure should be enhanced.
- FDP/Refresher Programmes for the teachers should be introduced.
- Interaction with the parents of students needs to be strengthened.
- There should be communicative English classes at the campus.
- Research culture should be promoted.

Feedback from Employer

- Skill based training should be implemented in the syllabus for better employment opportunities.
- Students to undertake industrial visits and short term industrial training programs.
- More of practical knowledge/experience is necessary to bridge class room industry gap.
