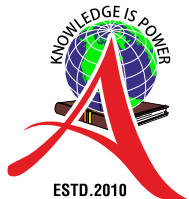

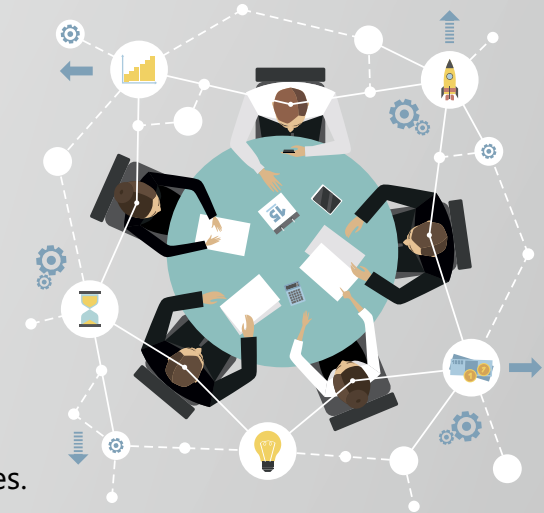
This is a three-year professional undergraduate course which provides a basic understanding of management education while also inculcating entrepreneurship skills.

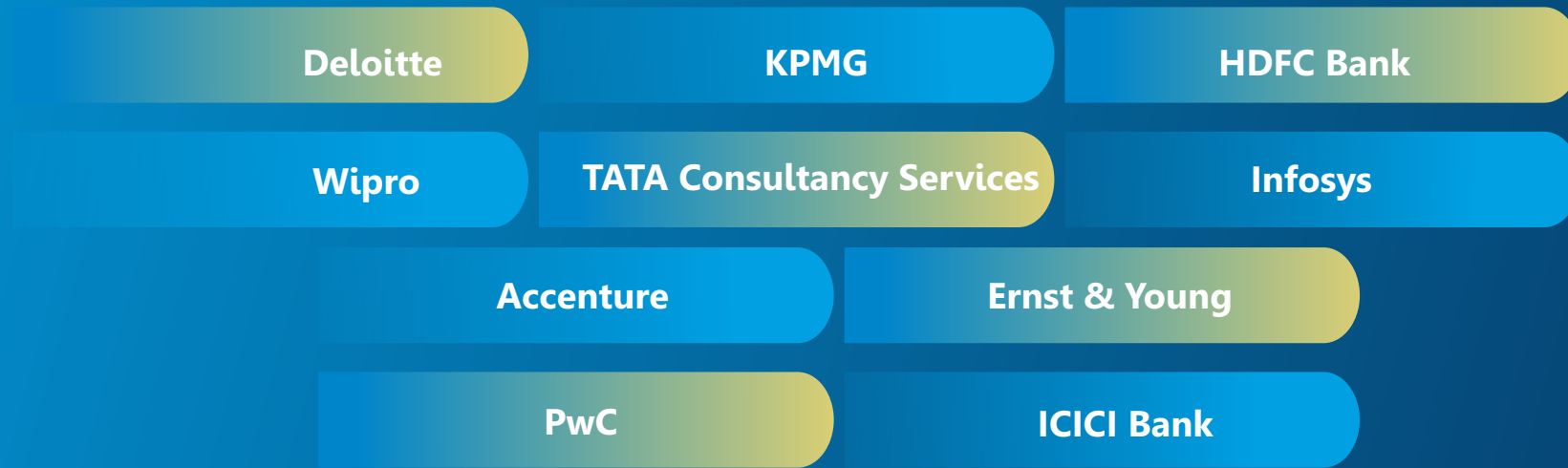

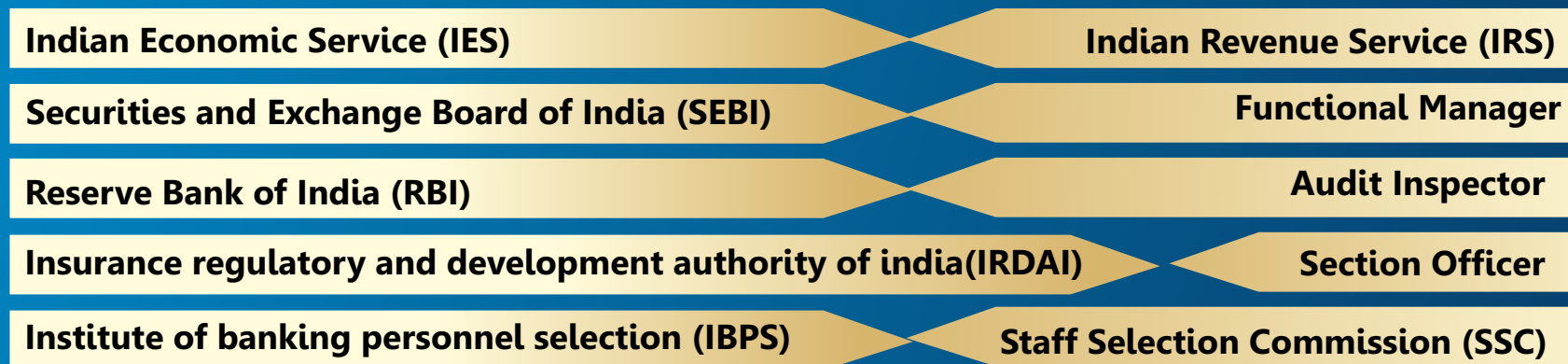

- Design and develop computer programs/computer-based systems in the areas related to algorithms, networking, web design, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning.

# DCHN (DIPLOMA IN COMPUTER HARDWARE AND NETWORKING)

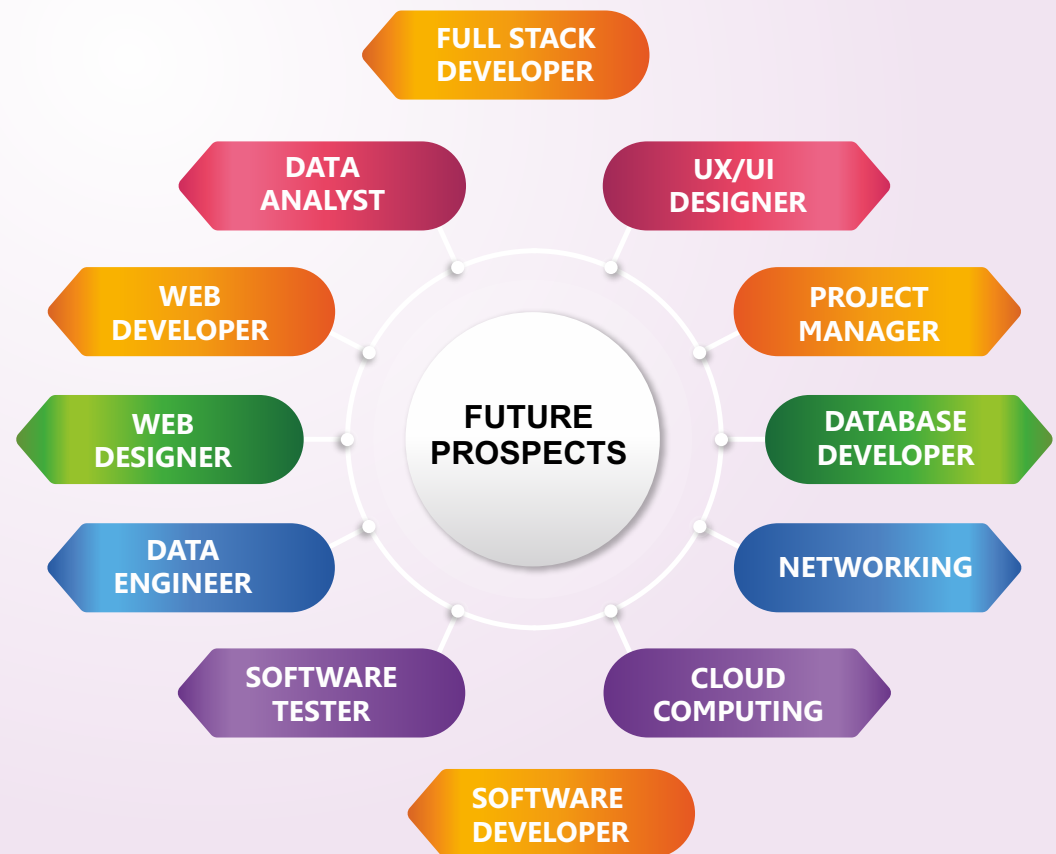



The Department has organized eight INSPIRE internship camps for school students.

# COURSES OFFERED

## UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMS

### **B.Sc.** (NON-MEDICAL/ NON-MEDICAL WITH COMPUTER APPLICATION)

This is a three-year undergraduate program which provides a basic understanding of physics, chemistry, mathematics, statistics and fundamentals of computer applications.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :**

- 10+2, with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks for SC/ST)

#### **PROGRAM OUTCOMES:**

- PO 1 :** To understand the concepts and significance of the various physical phenomena and carry out experiments to understand the laws and concepts of Physics.
- PO 2 :** Students empowered with distinct attributes for being able to find suitable employment.
- PO 3 :** It helps to develop scientific temper and thus can prove to be more beneficial for society as the scientific developments can make a nation or society to grow at rapid pace through research

### **B.Sc.** (MEDICAL)

It is a three year under graduate program which provide basic understanding about Botany, Zoology and Chemistry.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :**

- 10+2, with Medical Steam 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks for SC/ST)

#### **PROGRAM OUTCOMES:**

- PO 1 :** At the end of the course, the students learn to describe and appreciate the great diversity of plant life existing on the earth.
- PO 2 :** They come to understand hierarchy of different categories of plants.
- PO 3 :** The course improves the student's understanding of the concepts of fisheries, fishing tools and site selection, aqua culture systems, induced breeding techniques and post harvesting techniques.





## COURSES OFFERED

### **B.Sc.** (Computer, Statistics & Mathematics)

This is a three-year undergraduate program which provides a basic understanding of Fundamental of Computers, Statistics and Mathematics.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :**

- 10+2, with Mathematics 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks for SC/ST).

#### **PROGRAM OUTCOMES:**

- PO 1 :** To provide multidisciplinary expertise in Mathematical Sciences, Numerical Methods for Problem Solving, Statistical Modeling, and Scientific Computing.
- PO 2 :** Our course focuses on developing mathematical skills in Algebra, Calculus, Data Analysis, and Computing.

### **B.Sc.** ( Hons. Biotechnology)

This is a three-year undergraduate programs which provides a basic understanding of how to use technology to create useful products from living organisms.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :**

- 10+2 with Science subject from a recognize board.

#### **PROGRAM OUTCOMES:**

- PO 1 :** This stream's students are capable of doing bioinformatics and computer-assisted research.
- PO 2 :** Students know about numerous bimolecular processes at cellular level that are involved in the development of various technologies in this course.



## POST GRADUATE PROGRAMS

### M.Sc. (Chemistry)

This is a two-year postgraduate program which provides advanced-level knowledge about different streams of Organic, Inorganic, Physical, and Environmental Chemistry.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

- Graduation with Chemistry as compulsory subject.

#### PROGRAM OUTCOMES:

- PO 1 :** Students will be able to apply their knowledge to build up small scale industry for developing endogenous products.
- PO 2 :** Students will be able to implement various aspects of chemistry in natural products isolation, pharmaceuticals, dyes, polymers, petroleum products etc.
- PO 3 :** Students have sense of responsibility towards environment problems and apply their knowledge to solve the various environment related problems.

### M.Sc. (Mathematics)

This is a two year - postgraduate program which provides advanced advanced-level knowledge of different principles, methods and clear perception of numerous power of mathematics and tools.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

- Graduation with Mathematics as Elective Subject

#### PROGRAM OUTCOMES:

- PO 1 :** Students will be able to analyse scientific reasoning behind various phenomena.
- PO 2 :** Students will gain knowledge about both pure and applied branches of mathematics.
- PO 3 :** Students will be able to progress from concrete ideas of numbers to number sense.

#### JOB PROSPECTS :

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## MID-SEMESTER EXAMINATION

- (i) Mid-Semester Examination for semester system classes will be held twice in each semester.
- (ii) A student must obtain prior permission from the Principal for their inability to be present in the Mid-Semester Examination.
- (iii) Students, who do not qualify the Mid-Semester Examination as per University Rules or remain absent during the Mid-Semester Examination, may be allowed to appear in the Special Examination with the Principal's permission. Such students will have to pay a re-examination fee.

### **As per Punjabi University Norms, the following are the requirements for appearing in University Examination related to Mid Tests and attendance:**

- (i) The Eligibility to appear in university examination for all degree courses is 25% marks in aggregate or 25% marks in all individual subjects.
- (ii) The Attendance required to appear in university examinations is 75% of the total lectures delivered. The rules for condoning the shortage of lectures are as follows:
  - (a) The Principal can condone 6% of the lectures.
  - (b) Another 6% can be condoned by a committee constituted for this purpose.

## LEAVE RULES

- 1. The Name of the student will be struck off from the college register if they remain absent for 10 days without any leave application.
- 2. Sick Leave should be accompanied by a medical certificate issued by a doctor.
- 3. Leave applications should be countersigned by the parents or guardians of the students.
- 4. Every leave should be approved by the concerned Head of the Department.
- 5. No leave other than duty leave will be counted for the purpose of calculating lectures.

## LIBRARY RULES

- 1. The Library will remain open from 09:00am to 03:00pm on all working days.
- 2. A student can borrow a maximum of 02 books for 14 days.
- 3. Students can get a book reissued, only if there is no demand from other students.
- 4. There will be a fine of Rs. 2/- per day for books retained beyond the due date of return.
- 5. In case of damaging or losing a book, students will be responsible for expenses of replacing the book. If the book cannot be replaced due to non-availability, the fine will be determined by the Principal.
- 6. Students will not be issued reference books/ rare books/journals /magazines.
- 7. Issued books can be requisitioned any time by the Librarian.
- 8. Use of Mobile Phones in the Library is strictly prohibited.



### **PARKING RULES**

1. The students must park their vehicle in the parking area at their own risk. Nobody is allowed to park the vehicle on the road.
2. Do not sit in parked Vehicles.
3. Students are advised to get their cycles/Scooters/Motorcycles insured against theft and not to keep wallets, bags, money or cell phones in parked vehicles.

### **FINES FOR ABSENTEE**

The Fines for absences will be notified promptly on the college Notice Board.

### **COLLEGE LEAVING RULES**

- 1) A student desirous of leaving the college will have to apply in writing and the application must be countersigned by parents/guardian.
- 2) Students will have to return a book borrowed from the library and an Identity Card.
- 3) Students will pay all dues and fines.
- 4) Students will submit a "No Dues Certificate" in the office.
- 5) Certificates/Testimonials will not be issued to the student who leaves college without approval of the Principal or without submitting the, "No Due Certificate".
- 6) College leaving rules will be, as notified by the University from time to time.

### **FEE PAYMENT RULES**

1. Fee for odd semesters will be paid in June/July and fee for even semesters in November as per schedules to be notified by the College.
2. Students will ensure deposit of fee by the due date even if he/she is on leave.
3. A fine will be imposed on payment of the fee after the due date.
4. Name of the student will be struck off from college rolls in case of undue delay in deposit of fee. Such a student can get re-admission by depositing all dues and fines within 15 days.

### **REFUND OF FEE**

Last date for submission of application for claiming refund of fee is fixed by Punjabi University Patiala, Refund applications will be processed as per rules of Punjabi University, Patiala.

### **REFUND OF SECURITY**

1. The student will submit a Refund Form along with original receipt countersigned by parents/ guardians, in case of leaving the college/ migration completion of course.
2. If a student does not apply for a refund of security, no refund will be made after one year.
3. Form for refund of security should be submitted within the month of July/August.

### **MISCELLANEOUS RULES**

1. Ragging is an illegal offense. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college campus. Strict disciplinary or legal action will be taken against the student involved in an act of ragging.
2. Use of Mobile Phones is strictly Prohibited in the class rooms.
3. Every student must carry an Identity Card.
4. Section once allotted to the student will not be changed.
5. It is the responsibility of the student to read the notices put on notice board every day.
6. Rules mentioned in the prospectus can be changed from time to time.
7. College should be immediately informed in case of change of Phone number of parents / guardian.
