



In reference to your letter no. 138 dated 25-06-15 regarding the above subject, it is informed that the Vice Chancellor has granted approval in the report submitted by the inspection committee (copy attached) in anticipation of the approval of the Academic council. Apart from under the conditions/instructions/NCTE of B.Ed (Two year) Course Part from session 2015-16 Under NRC /NCT NRCAPP-4578/5791/7706/8764/4257/4261/563189849-868 dated 3 march 2015 Asian College of Education, Village Kasiana, District Patiala (village, Kasiana, Distr. Patiala) for (two units i.e. 100) has granted affiliation.

• By obtaining the approval of the map of the building constructed for the college from the Chief Town Planner, the Provisional concerned letter should be received and sent within 2 months from the date of issue.

The appointment letter/joining report of the remaining required teaching staff should be sent immediately.

An Endowment Fund amounting to Rs. 20 lakhs is to be deposited with the University, within one month from the date of issuance of this letter, in the form of F.D.R. in the name of Dean, College Development Council, Punjabi University, Patiala.

In case of cancellation of the affiliation of the College by the University or college Management requests for withdrawal of affiliation, the college Management (President/Chairman/General Secretary) will have to give an affidavit duly attested by 1st class Magistrate on 25/- rupees stamp paper to the effect that nothing is due of the teaching, non-teaching staff and students towards college only then F.D.R deposited with the University will be released.

The College will have to deposit the affiliation continuation fees every year, as per University norms, latest by 31 August.

In case, there is any revision in Endowment Fund/Affiliation Fee/Continuation Fee by the Syndicate, the College is bound to pay the difference.

The College will charge tuition fee and other charges as approved by the University and will maintain proper register/record of the same. No other fees and funds shall be charged by the College.

The Principal, teaching staff and librarian will be recruited/appointed as per U.G.C./Punjabi University. Patiala norms/qualifications through a properly constitute. Selection Committee under the rules.

6. The College shall pay salary to the faculty in the UGC grades as adopted by the Punjabi University Patiala. An affidavit to this effect, signed by the President of the Foundation/Trust/Society, and duly attested by the Magistrate (First Class), will be submitted to the University. The College will maintain the proper record of the salary of the faculty and staff.

7. The College will send cases of the duly selected/appointed Principal/Faculty/Librarian, for

approval from University, within one month from the date of their appointments.

8. The College shall submit the list of faculty members and supporting staff at the beginning of each Academic Year, latest by 15 August, every year. Any change in the management and all changes in the teaching faculty/staff shall be reported to the university immediately.

9. The College will not, without the prior permission of the Academic Council, suspendinstruction in any subject or course of study for which it is authorized to impart

instructions.

10. The College shall have a regularly constituted Governing body consisting of not more than twenty persons including, among others, two representatives of the University and will hold regular meetings of the Governing Body. The university representatives shall be appointed by the University.

11. The College building will not be used for any other purpose.

12. College once affiliated to this University, will not seek affiliation to any other University for any course(5)/subject(s).

13. The college will submit each year the statement of Annual Accounts to the University. duly audited by a chartered accountant, latest by 30 June, every year.

14. The College will provide the hostels and Principal residence in the College Campus.

15. The requisite certificates NOC such as conversion certificate and approval of the building plan etc. by the competent authority of the Punjab Govt, will be submitted within one month.

16. The College must have arrangement with good practising high schools which should have experienced staff and educate equipment. The list of such schools along with the certificate from the school the head to this effect, be also supplied to the university.

17. The College will ensure compliance of conditions of NCTE, Jaipur imposed vide their letter No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-4578/5791/7706/8764/4257/4261/5631/89849-868 dated 3 Mar 2015.

18. The College will be bound to abide by the University/NCTE/Punjab Government rules issued from time to time.

19. If a college does not satisfy the conditions imposed by the University regarding affiliation or extension of affiliation even after a reasonable time has been allowed to the college or makes violation of the conditions of affiliation imposed from time to time, the matter shall be reported to the Academic Council/Syndicate (as the case may be), by the Dean, College Development Council for such action against the college as the Academic Council/Syndicate may deem fit. Under section 12 of Chapter VI, Punjabi University.

In addition to the conditions mentioned in the report, a report should be sent on every point with details by fulfilling the above conditions/instructions.

20,00,000/- as endowment fund for co-educational college has seen received in the name of FDR Dean, College Development Council. A bank draft of Rs. 1,00,000/- has been received in the name of the Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala as the relevant fee, but due to the 2 year of the B.Ed fee, NCTE has decided the matter regarding the determination of the relevant fee by the University is under consideration. As per the relevant fee which will be determined by the University, it will be mandatory to deposit the required bank draft of the relevant fee immediately.

It is clear that the approval for B.Ed Part-II will be mandatory taken from university.

In addition to the above Condition/Instructions, it is clarified that if at any stage the documents sent by the society regarding the land of the college such as land registry, fard, non-encumbrance Certificate and other necessary documents are found to be wrong; then all the responsibility will be of the society of College itself and in this case, the university can also cancel the affiliation of the college. Along with this, if there is a dispute between the college society in itself, then the college society itself will be responsible and the university will not be a participate in it.


